SJAMHA Mentorship Program: Types of Mentorship

Mentorships are the most important part of development as an official. All level 1 and 2 officials in SJAMHA will be supervised at least twice before the end of February using a combination of three types of mentorships:

- 1. **Shadow Mentorship** (first year officials only): a mentor will come onto the ice with an official to help with positioning, procedure and game management.
- 2. **Penalty Box**: a mentor will watch from the penalty box and offer advice at appropriate times such as between periods or during long stoppages of play.
- 3. **Stands**: a mentor will watch from the stands and will provide feedback when the ice is being flooded.

Although these are three types of mentorship styles, a mentor may also use a combination of the three in any given game.
